## What's cooking in the kitchen?

### GRANDMA'S CHICKEN

#### Ingredients

- 8 skinless, boneless chicken breast halves
- 1 egg
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 2 teaspoons garlic powder, divided
- 1 cup bread crumbs
- 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 pound sliced fresh mushrooms
- 1/4 cup butter, melted
- 1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon chopped fresh parsley

#### Directions

1. Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C).
2. In a shallow bowl, beat the egg with salt, pepper and 1 teaspoon garlic powder. In a separate dish, mix bread crumbs with 1 teaspoon of garlic powder and Parmesan cheese. Set aside.
3. Mix together the melted butter and lemon juice. Pour about 2/3 of the butter mixture into the bottom of a 9x13 inch baking dish. Tilt pan to coat the bottom. Spread mushrooms in an even layer in the bottom of the dish. Dip each chicken breast into the egg mixture, then into the bread crumb mixture. Place on top of the mushrooms. Drizzle remaining butter over the chicken, and sprinkle with parsley.
3. Bake uncovered for 45 minutes in the preheated oven, until chicken is golden brown and juices run clear.

## Retirement from a Child's Point of View

After Christmas break, a teacher asked her young pupils how they spent their holidays. One small boy wrote the following:

We always spent Christmas with my Grandma and Grandpa. They lived here in a big brick home, but Grandpa retarded from his job and they moved to Florida. Now they live in little tin boxes. My Grandma said Grandpa worked all his life and earned his retardment, I wish they would move back up here, but I guess the little man in the doll house won't let them out.
